AN ORDER APPROPRIATING \$8,336,514 FOR A REPAIR PROJECT AT THE JOHN AVERY PARKER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND AMENDING THE ORDERS PASSED SEPTEMBER 1, 2015 AND MARCH 22, 2016 TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF EACH SUCH ORDER BE ALLOCATED TO THE JOHN AVERY PARKER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL REPAIR PROJECT.

BE IT ORDERED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS FOLLOWS:

That the City appropriate the amount of Eight Million Three Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$8,336,514) for the purpose of paying the costs of repairs to the John Avery Parker Elementary School consisting of the replacement of windows and doors, the abatement of hazardous materials, handicap accessibility improvements, and a new fire protection system, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the "Project"): which proposed repair project will materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, and for which the City has applied for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the School Committee; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance is authorized to borrow such amount under M.G.L. Chapter 44, Chapter 70B, or pursuant to any other enabling authority; that the City acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program

based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the City incurs in excess of any grant that may be received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City; provided further that any grant that City of New Bedford may receive from the MSBA for the Project shall not exceed the lesser of (1) eighty percent (80%) of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (2) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA; and provided that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this order shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the City and the MSBA; and further that a portion of the amount appropriated and authorized to be borrowed under this order shall be provided by (i) a transfer of \$1,500,000 of the appropriation and borrowing authority for the demolition of the John Hannigan School and construction of a new PK-5 school authorized by the order of the City Council passed September 10, 2015, and that such order be amended to reduce the appropriation and borrowing authority accordingly, and (ii) a transfer of \$500,000 of the appropriation and borrowing authority for accelerated repair projects at Carney Academy and the Hayden McFadden, Casimir Pulaski and Alfred J. Gomes Elementary Schools and that such order is hereby amended to reduce the appropriation and borrowing authority accordingly, and that such reduction shall be allocated among the schools as necessary at the discretion of the Treasurer; and that the Treasurer is authorized to file an application with the Municipal Finance Oversight Board to qualify under Chapter 44A of the General Laws any or all the bonds and to provide such information and execute such documents as the Municipal Finance Oversight Board may require for these purposes.
