



Everyone in your family should sit down and plan what to do in case of a fire in your home. As a Junior Fire Inspector you can help by making sure that you:

- PLAN AT LEAST TWO ESCAPE ROUTES.
- PRACTICE THE ESCAPE ROUTES DURING FIRE DRILLS.
- KEEP LOW TO THE FLOOR AND CRAWL TO THE NEAREST EXIT.
- TOUCH DOORS BEFORE OPENING THEM. If warm, it could mean there's fire on the other side. Use another exit.
- · COVER YOUR MOUTH AND NOSE.
- GO TO AN OUTSIDE MEETING PLACE.
- NEVER GO BACK INTO A BURNING BUILDING.
